Eligibility Application Requirements

Veteran Organizations

Please note that it is the responsibility of the applying organization to provide all applicable and necessary documentation for review to Arkansas Federal Surplus Property (AR FSP). AR FSP may require additional information other than what is listed on a case by case scenario. Failure to submit all required documentation will result in delay of approval. Please provide the following:

1. Eligibility Application packet with all requested information properly completed and signed by the Senior Official/ Director/equivalent. (7 pages total)
2. Narrative on Official Letterhead that includes the following information:
 - Description of what the organization does, services provided, etc.
 - # of employees/volunteers
 - # of participants
 - Percentage (%) of participants that are veterans (minimum of 33%)
 - Sources of funding
3. Copy of Charter.
4. Copy of Articles of Incorporation and By-laws.
5. Copy of last financial summary report, to equal one (1) year (do not send bank statements).

Applications, by regulation, are required to be renewed every three (3) years and when a new authorizing official comes into office. Please retain a copy for your records. Applications may be submitted to AR FSP via e-mail, fax, or mail. 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§102-37.380 (d) Section 549 (c)(3)(C) of title 40, United States Code authorizes for the donation of property to veteran organizations, for purposes of provide services to veterans (as defined in section 101 of title 38). Eligible organizations are those whose:

- (1) Membership comprises substantially veterans; and
- (2) Representatives are recognized by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs under section 5902 of title 38.
