The following is the schedule for the Public Assistance (Infrastructure) Grant Program applicant briefings for the April 27, 2009 and continuing severe storms, tornadoes, and flooding.

State agencies, cities, counties, public education facilities and potential eligible Private Nonprofit Organizations that provide essential governmental services (Critical/Non-Critical) that incurred costs or sustained damages should plan to attend one of these briefings. Applicants have until July 16, 2009 (30 days from the date of disaster declaration) to submit an application to the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management for federal and state financial assistance. If date or location of briefing is not convenient, you may attend any one of choice. We recommend representatives from each organization to be management, public works, and accounting/finance.

- Effective Ruling Letter from the IRS granting Tax Exemption under section 501 (c), (d), (e), etc.
- State Certification as a Private Non-Profit and State Tax ID#
- Provide a copy of By-Laws and/or Charters
- PNP Facility Questionnaire

These are required to determine eligibility
